GA & Acteens Camp Rules

1. Both Counselors and Campers shall be respectful of the Camp leaders, other campers and the campgrounds, remembering that we are in a place set apart for The Lord's ministry, and shall respect it as such.
2. All Counselors and Campers shall respect the time set for lights out/bedtime. Please let other campers rest!
3. Please do not bring electronic devices (MP3's, 4's, tablets, laptops, etc.) These will only be a distraction. Counselors, please be an example! You are allowed to bring cell phones for emergency use only and to contact parents, but we ask that each counselor keep the camper's cell phones with them.
4. All Counselors must be a female, age 18 or over. No male campers allowed. All campers must be accompanied by a Counselor.
5. All Counselors and Campers shall dress accordingly, but respectfully. Ladies and girls, please no *short* shorts. Use the fingertip rule as a guide. When you place your hands at your side your shorts should be longer than your middle finger.
6. Counselors, please respect the speed limit while driving within the campgrounds.

7. All Counselors and Campers will participate in Camp activities. Please do not leave the campgrounds during scheduled activities. The insurance will not cover you in the case of an accident outside the campgrounds.
8. A counselor who knows how to swim must accompany any girls going canoeing or swimming at the river. Campers are required to wear life vests while using the canoes.
9. No open campfires are allowed.
10. Come with a good attitude, ready to have fun!
